In the past, CFR SCCA[®] Solo[®] has implemented Ladies' classes in the same way as is implemented for SCCA[®] Solo[®] national events. That is with specific Ladies' classes for each of the existing "open" classes. Furthermore, we have used the standard bumping rules which dictated that single entrant Ladies' classes were first bumped to their respective open classes, then bumped if necessary according to the open class bumping order.

Due to dwindling participation in the Ladies' Classes for our local events over recent years, the 2019 Ladies' Class will be implemented as a single Ladies' PAX Class. This is consistent with many regions across the country. The Ladies' Pax class will run together and be scored against each other using the PAX handicap system.

As always, competitors are free to choose the "Open" class if they so desire.

REGISTERING FOR LADIES' CLASS ON MOTORSPORTREG.COM

To register for Ladies' Class for a CFR SCCA[®] Solo[®] event, on Motorsportreg.com a participant will select as "Class" the SCCA[®] Solo[®] class of the vehicle. Then in the "PAX" selection box, the registrant should select "Ladies'".

CLASS DESIGNATION

The class designation for the Ladies' Class will be according to the SCCA[®] Solo[®] classing for national Ladies' classes. For example, and "FS" competitor in the CFR SCCA[®] Solo[®] Ladies' Class will use the class markings "FSL". The numbers will be as usual.

COMPETITIVE RULES FOR LADIES' CLASS

- Ladies' Class will compete as a single class using PAX correction factors based on the legal class of the car.
- Ladies' Class competitors will compete during the same heat.
- Ladies' Class will not be bumped.
- Ladies' Class will be able to use the same number as someone competing in the equivalent open class.
- Up to two drivers can compete in a single car in Ladies' class. The same car would also be eligible for up to two drivers in the open class.
- Event trophies/credits will be awarded up to three places as follows:
 - 1st Place Trophy for 1 to 4 competitors in class
 - 1st & 2nd Place Trophies for 5 to 7 competitors in class
 - 1st, 2nd, & 3rd Place trophies for 8 or greater competitors in class
- Three year-end trophies will be given to the top three Ladies' Class competitors, subject to competing in the required number of events.

THE FUTURE OF LADIES' CLASS

It is hoped that this change will foster and encourage more Ladies' Class competitors to compete with CFR SCCA[®] Solo[®]. Whatever the results in this regard, at year-end, competitor feedback will be solicited, and these rules will be re-evaluated and modified for the following year in order to best serve our Ladies' Class competitors.
